



## ***Camellia sasanqua ‘Setsugekka’***

*Camellia Setsugekka is a fantastic early flowering, evergreen Camellia perfect for hedges or informal screens.*

*This top selling variety produces medium sized, semi double white flowers early autumn through to early winter. Frost and wind tolerant*

### ***Where to Grow***

- *As a formal hedge*
- *For use as a screen for boundaries*
- *Containers to brighten up patios and courtyards.*
- *In garden beds as a stand-alone specimen*

### ***Planting***

- *Plant from autumn through to early summer*
- *Requires well drained soil*
- *If planting in containers, use a good container mix containing a slow release fertilizer, ensuring the container has good drainage. Water well.*
- *Camellia Setsugekka grows 3M high by 1.5M wide.*
- *Prefers semi-shade*

### ***Care***

- *Water well while the plant is establishing itself*
- *To maintain shape and height trim after flowering has finished*
- *Feed early spring and autumn with Camellia fertilizer*
