



Heucheras

A fantastic range of evergreen foliage perennials known as Coral Bells. Planted in groups as an accent plant Heucheras have a wide range of uses in the garden including borders, containers and use as a ground cover. The foliage is set off by long lasting, small bell like flowers produced on spikes during spring. To add interest often the tones of Heucheras foliage change in response to changing temperatures and seasons.

Where to Grow

Heucheras prefer to be planted in sun to part shade as a general rule of thumb the lighter the foliage the less sun they require. Jet black Heucheras will tolerate full sun where lime greens will need shade.

- *Garden borders and rockeries*
- *Containers to brighten up Patios and courtyards.*
- *Mixed garden beds*
- *Woodland planting*

Planting

- *Plant either in the garden or containers during Spring, Summer, Autumn or early Winter*
- *Planted in the garden Heucheras require well drained soil*
- *Do not bury the crown of Heucheras when planting*
- *If planting in containers, use a good container mix containing a slow release fertilizer, ensuring the container has good drainage. Water well.*

Care

- *Water well while the plant is establishing itself*
- *When flowering has finished cut off flower spikes*
- *If planted in containers monitor and water regularly, do not allow to dry out*
Feed occasionally with a Slow release fertilizer.
