



Lavender ‘Ghostly Princess’

A beautiful cold hardy lavender selected for its lengthy flowering season and stunning year round silver foliage, adding a modern style and feel to any home. Dusky pink flowers blanket the plant in spring complimenting and adding another dimension to this fashionably versatile plant.

- *Striking silver foliage complimented with distinctive dark pink, flowering inflorescences and pale pink bracts*
- *Neat compact habit, low maintenance*
- *Main flowering flush begins from late winter continuing throughout the Spring months*
- *Bred in Australia and selected for foliage and flower colour, easy care and compact habit.*

Where to Grow

- *Stunning planted as hedging in entrance ways and entertaining areas for maximum impact of foliage colour*
- *Plant as a hedge for foliage and flower effect*
- *For maximum effect mass plant in garden beds*
- *Positioned in the garden for attracting bees*
- *In containers to brighten up patios and courtyards.*

Planting

- *Plant from late Winter through to late Autumn*
- *Plant in well-drained soil in a sunny position*
- *If planting in containers, use a good container mix containing a slow release fertilizer, ensure that the container has good drainage.*

Care

- *Water well while the plant is establishing itself.*
- *If planted in containers monitor and water regularly, do not allow to dry out.*
- *Feed early spring with a slow release fertilizer.*
- *To extend flowering period de-head flowers that have finished*
- *To encourage new growth and continued flowering trim lightly after flowers have finished.*
- *To stop plants becoming woody established plants can be trimmed by a third in late summer*
