



Origanum Bellissimo

Origanum Bellissimo is a showy ornamental plant which has been bred to withstand hot and dry conditions. The aromatic foliage spreads and trails producing deep plum coloured bracts from late spring throughout summer. This versatile plant makes a spectacular container or garden specimen.

Where to Grow

- *Origanum Bellissimo* prefers to be planted in a sunny well drained spot
- Use as a ground cover in a garden bed which give a showy display right into Autumn.
- Plant in pots for a show display of deep plum colour with a lovely weeping habit.
- Can be planting on walls for a weeping effect
- Grows 20cm tall x 1m wide

Planting

- Plant in spring, early summer through to early Autumn
- Add slow release fertiliser at the time of planting
- Water well until plant is established

Care

- To encourage new growth remove old growth spring
- Trim lightly when flowering has finished
- Apply a slow release fertiliser in spring
