



Hellebores

Hellebores also known as 'Winter Roses' are a fantastic plant to add a burst of colour to the garden late winter and early Spring. These hardy perennials are easy to grow and reward the gardener with flowers for weeks when there is not a lot of colour in the garden. Recently new breeding programs of this plant has meant there are many stunning new selections and colours on offer in garden centres. New Hellebore varieties recently released on the market certainly have the added appeal of a plant which can be used "Indoors for a moment... Outdoors for a lifetime"

Perfect to use as a cut flower.

Where to Grow

- *Mass planted in woodland gardens.*
- *Under the canopy of deciduous trees or shrubs.*
- *In containers to brighten up patios and courtyards.*

Planting

- *Plant from late Autumn to early Spring.*
- *Planted in the garden Hellebores requires a semi-shaded spot with filtered light.*
- *Plant in well-drained soil.*
- *If planting in containers, use a good container mix containing a slow release fertilizer, ensure that the container has good drainage.*

Care

- *Water well while the plant is establishing itself.*
- *If planted in containers monitor and water regularly, do not allow to dry out.*
- *Feed occasionally with a slow release fertilizer.*
- *To encourage new growth and continued flowering trim lightly after flowers have finished.*
