



## **Lavender ‘The Princess’**

*'The Princess' Lavender is an early flowering lavender, bearing fantastic vivid electric pink flower heads throughout spring and early summer, with spot flowering continuing throughout summer and autumn. 'The Princess' Lavender has a tight compact habit, with aromatic grey green foliage. The flowers are born on stems above the plant, forming domes of bright colour and an impressive display for any garden.*

*Lavenders are great for attracting bees into the garden, and planted near edible plants bees will help to pollinate the crops.*

### **Where to Grow**

- *For maximum effect mass plant in garden beds*
- *Plant as a hedge for foliage and flower effect*
- *Positioned in the garden for attracting bees*
- *In containers to brighten up patios and courtyards.*

### **Planting**

- *Plant from late Winter through to late Autumn*
- *Plant in well-drained soil.*
- *If planting in containers, use a good container mix containing a slow release fertilizer, ensure that the container has good drainage.*

### **Care**

- *Water well while the plant is establishing itself.*
- *If planted in containers monitor and water regularly, do not allow to dry out.*
- *Feed early spring with a slow release fertilizer.*
- *To extend flowering period de-head flowers that have finished*
- *To encourage new growth and continued flowering trim lightly after flowers have finished.*
- *To stop plants becoming woody established plants can be trimmed by a third in late summer*
